General policy: All children under 8 years old must be accompanied in the water by a responsible person who is 16 years or above and is a competent swimmer of 25 metres or more.



Children under 4 years:

- A responsible person must be present in the water with the children at all times.
- Children must wear approved floatation devices unless the ratio is 1:1 and the responsible person is in constant contact.
- Children and responsible person must stay in the designated safe area.



Children aged 4-7 years:

- A responsible person must be present in the water with the children at all times.
- If children are not confident swimmers, approved floatation devices must be worn and they must stay within designated safe areas.



Children 8 years & over:

- No parent supervision required provided the child can swim at least 25 metres.
- Children must be able to swim 25 metres as a minimum.
